From Tulsa, take the Muskogee Turnpike east (portions toll), merge onto US-69 heading south via EXIT 26 toward Muskogee. Go 6.5 miles and turn left onto US-62 BR / US-64 BR / West Okmulgee Street. Jasper's is about .7 miles, where the road bends, on the left. The Civic Assembly Center is past Jasper's another mile on Okmulgee, at Fourth.
